



The Accidental Artist

A One Day Workshop with Laura Wasilowski

When you design quilts as you go, you embrace serendipity and become an “accidental artist”. Learn 3 methods of creating fused quilt designs in an improvisational manner. Begin with a heap of pre-fused fabric scraps from Laura's stash to trigger your design ideas. Select from several examples of systems for constructing your artwork and put your colorful fabric kit to good use. You'll create and learn as you go. It's fun to design on the fly! (No sewing machine is needed.)

Supplies Participants Should Bring:

- 2 yards of regular weight Wonder-Under fusible web (paperbacked #805). Please DO NOT BRING Heat 'n Bond or Steam a Seam
- Sharp scissors like small 5" knife blade scissors
- Paper scissors
- Rotary cutters, ruler and mat
- Specialty blades, like Pinking, Wavy, or Scallop (optional)
- Batting, 1 piece measuring about 18" x 18"
- Quilt backing fabric, 1 piece measuring about 18" x 18"
- Thimble (optional)
- Small plastic bag for fabric scraps
- Tweezers (optional).

\$25 Kit Fee: Includes hand out, pre-fused scraps, hand-dyed fabrics and threads, and a needle.

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
