

## Twenty Years - Sally Frey Workshop

This pattern is so universal you can use a wide variety of fabrics. I have made it in Halloween, Christmas and very traditional fabrics. It also works great in flannel for a cozy winter throw. The pattern is Sparkling Cider from "All Washed Up". I will be providing the pattern in class.

Lap size: 64" X 80"

### Supply List:

Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine in good working order

Rotary cutter, mat and basic rulers

"Quilt in a Day Large Flying Geese Ruler" (2"X4" / 4" X 8")

### Fabrics:

20 Fat Quarters - a bundle of a fabric line works perfect or choose a wide variety of fat quarters.

1  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards of background

### Pre-Cutting before class:

You will be cutting the fabrics for the (4) big stars before class.

From (4) fat quarters cut (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and (1) 11" square.

From the background cut (4) 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

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
