MorningStar + EveningStar - 72" x 72"

this pattern is taking us beyond the half square triangle - and on to the half rectangle triangle

the MorningStar quilt is made up of three different blocks - we'll review cutting and piecing each of the three blocks, while talking about tips and tricks to make this quilt a breeze to make!

it's a piecing class - and we'll also be fine tuning our piecing accuracy (bloc loc ruler strongly suggested!)

experience level strong beginner/intermediate quilter

tool box

sewing machine, in good working order, with manual
 small scissors and thread snippers
 cutting mat and 6-1/2 x 24" ruler and medium 9-1/2" square ruler
 blocloc HRT Ruler Set (4-1/2" x 8-1/2")
 rotary cutter with new blade (45 or 28mm)
 piecing threads in neutral grey, 3-5 loaded bobbins of the same thread
 beyond the reef pattern - MorningStar + EveningStar

pens, notebook, camera

fabrics

color, color, color - 7 different half-yard fabrics
 accent - 2-1/4 yards charcoal or dark grey/black accent
 backgrounds - 3-1/4 yards total light background fabrics
 note: pattern quilt background utilized three (3) different black and white prints
 (for binding and backing, refer to pattern)

miscellaneous

bring any other items necessary for your own personal comfort
 we will be creating these big blocks with a lot of hands on machine time
