Class Description

This pattern is a "down sized" version of "House Party" that I made several years ago. The houses in the windows have been redecorated and the trees have been replanted. This class will cover a few different techniques, such as needle-turn hand applique, wool applique and liberated points. There will only be time to get some parts made but you should be able to get a good idea of just how you want your future "house" to look.

SUPPLY LIST

BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES/SEWING MACHINE IN GOOD WORKING ORDER
Pattern Required

FABRIC

Light Grey Background: 2 yards
Small House (window) Background: 2/3 yard
Small Houses: Multiple scraps of cottons and wools
Main House Sashing: 2/3 yard
Roof: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
Chimney: 8"x16" minimum
Tree Trunks: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard cut
Liberated Tree Bough Points: Green/1/4 yard - Orange/1/4 yard
Ground: 2/3 yard
Wool Circle Shrubs: Larger scraps of good quality felted wool in multiple colors.

THREADS:

Genziana Wool Thread: a variety of colors to match the wool appliqued shapes.
50wt cotton thread for cotton applique: a variety of colors to match the color of the shapes.

Decorative Stitches on Small Houses: a variety of pearl cottons in various weights and colors.

NOTE: We will discuss the decorative stitching in class but will not have the time to apply. This requires another class just about stitching.

NOTIONS:

Basic Sewing Supplies/Sewing Machine in good working order.

Paper and Fabric Scissors

Small Sharp Embroidery Scissors

Needles: #10 or #11 Milliners or Straw for cotton applique, #24 Chenille for wool applique.

#2 pencil, Light colored Chalk Marking Pencil, Black Sharpie Fine Point

$\frac{1}{4}$ " Clover Bias Tape Maker

Glass Head Pins (these come in several different lengths. I like the 35mm or shorter.)

Thimble: Optional

NOTE: Another reminder that this class will only get you started towards construction. The main concentration will be in learning a few new techniques that will help you along your way when building "your house".
