

Pineapple Farm

61" x 69" quilt

Intermediate Skill Level

Pineapple Farm blocks are the perfect place to show off your favorite fabrics. These unique "woven" patchwork blocks are made in sets using conventional patchwork techniques. No paper piecing! The class will cover all aspects of making the blocks, including tips and tricks for precision piecing and keeping cut pieces organized as you work.

Students are encouraged to cut background fabric in advance.

Supplies:

- Pineapple Farm Quilt Pattern by Elizabeth Hartman
- Sewing Machine with quarter inch piecing foot
- Thread for piecing
- Basic sewing kit, including scissors, seam ripper, etc.
- Basic quilting supplies including cutting mat, ruler, and rotary cutter. Due to the space in the classroom, a small mat is recommended. A rectangular ruler, such as a 4" x 14" ruler, will be more useful than a square ruler.
- Fabric marking tool, such as water-soluble marker or Chaco liner.
- Blue painter's tape and Sharpie for labeling cut pieces
- 2 sheets printer paper, pencil, and paper scissors

Materials:

- 3-7/8 yards mid-tone neutral background fabric
- 21 fat quarters* (18" x 21") or 60 fabric squares 10" x 10" each for pineapple bodies
- 7 fat quarters** (18" x 21") or 20 fabric squares 10" x 10" each for pineapple leaves

*Actual fabric used is 12" x 21".

**Actual fabric used is 14" x 21".

The following fabrics will not be used in class:

- 4-3/8 yards backing fabric
- 5/8 yard binding fabric
