

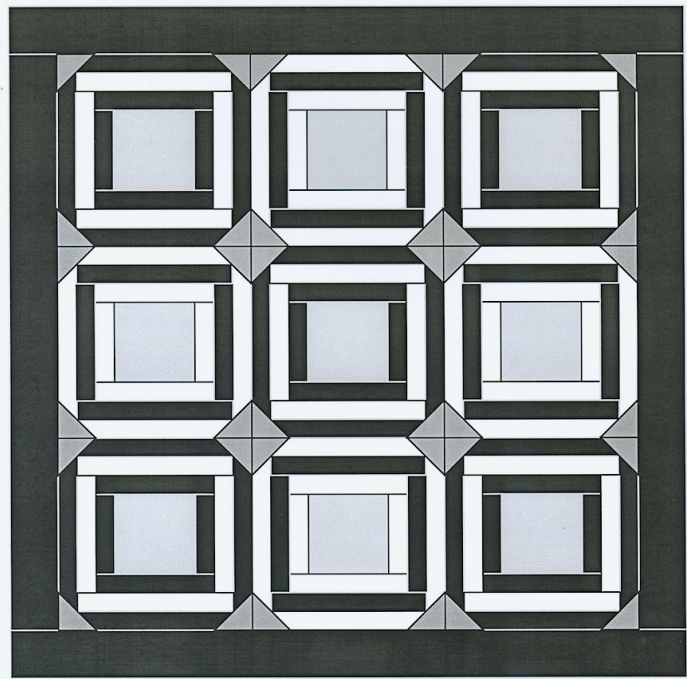
Stitchin' Post Free Pattern

Select either a pre-packaged set of centers for the squares or use choose 1/3 yard of a theme print for the centers of the blocks. The finished block size is 10 1/4" and the finished quilt size is 36 3/4" x 36 3/4"

Materials Needed:

- 1 package of 9 Hand Painted Batiks
- 3/8 yard of a black print for the dark logs (1st dark)
- 1/3 yard of a black print for the dark logs (2nd dark)
- 3/8 yard of a white print for the light logs (1st light)
- 1/3 yard of a light print for the light logs (2nd light)
- 1/4 yard for the spark
- 3/4 yard black for border and binding

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cut 9 center squares 4 3/4" x 4 3/4".

From the 1st dark cut 7 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips. From these strips cut the following: 10 - 1 1/2" x 4 3/4" logs, 18 - 1 1/2" x 6 3/4" logs, and 8 - 1 1/2" x 8 3/4" logs

From the 2nd dark cut 5 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips. From these strips cut the following: 10 - 1 1/2" x 8 3/4" logs and 10 - 1 1/2" x 10 3/4" logs. *Please note that you should cut 2 - 8 3/4" logs and 2 - 10 3/4" logs from each strip.

From the 1st light cut 7 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips. From these strips cut the following: 8 - 1 1/2" x 4 3/4" logs, 18 - 1 1/2" x 6 3/4" logs, and 10 - 1 1/2" x 8 3/4" logs.

From the 2nd light cut 5 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips. From these strips cut the following: 8 - 1 1/2" x 8 3/4" logs and 8 - 1 1/2" x 10 3/4" logs. *Please note that you should cut 2 - 8 3/4" logs and 2 - 10 3/4" logs from each strip.

From the spark cut 3 - 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Then cut into 36 - 2 1/2" squares.

From the border fabric cut 4 - 3 1/2" x 42" strips. Then cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 31 1/4" strips for the side borders and 2 - 3 1/2" x 37 1/4" for the top and bottom borders.

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Sew a 1st dark 1 1/2" x 4 3/4" log to the sides of 5 of the center squares. Press. Sew a 1st dark 1 1/2" x 6 3/4" log to the top and bottom of these 5 units. Press. Sew a 1st light 1 1/2" x 6 3/4" log to the sides of these units. Press. Next sew a 1st light 1 1/2" x 8 3/4" log to the top and bottom of these units. Press. Sew a 2nd dark

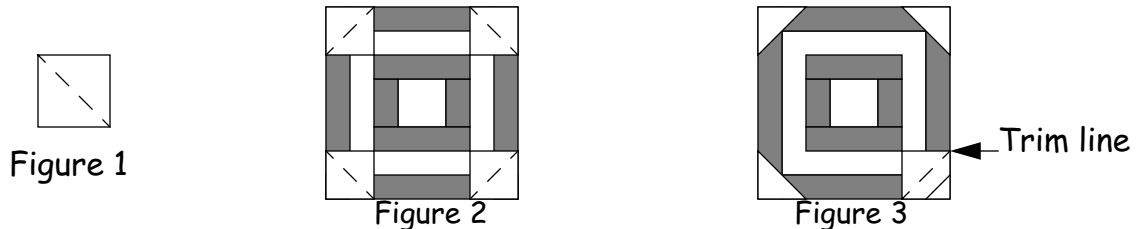
1 1/2" x 8 3/4" log to the sides of the units. Press. Sew a 2nd dark 1 1/2" x 10 3/4" log to the top and bottom of the units. Press.

2. Sew a 1st light 1 1/2" x 4 3/4" log to the sides of 4 of the center squares. Press. Sew a 1st light 1 1/2" x 6 3/4" log to the top and bottom of these 4 units. Press. Sew a 1st dark 1 1/2" x 6 3/4" log to the sides of these units. Press. Next sew a 1st dark 1 1/2" x 8 3/4" log to the top and bottom of these units. Press. Sew a 2nd light 1 1/2" x 8 3/4" log to the sides of the units. Press. Sew a 2nd light 1 1/2" x 10 3/4" log to the top and bottom of the units. Press.

3. Either diagonally press or diagonally draw a pencil line on the wrong side of the 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" spark squares. Figure 1.

Place right sides together to the corners of the blocks and sew diagonally on the marked line. Figure 2.

Trim 1/4" away from the outside edge and press. Figure 3.



4. Referring to the illustration, sew the blocks together in rows. Press. Sew the rows together.

5. Sew the 3 1/2" x 31 1/4" side border strips to each side of the quilt. Press. Sew the 3 1/2" x 37 1/4" top and bottom border strips to the quilt. Press.

6. Layer and quilt. We quilted in the ditch around the blocks, then quilted a simple design in the border.
