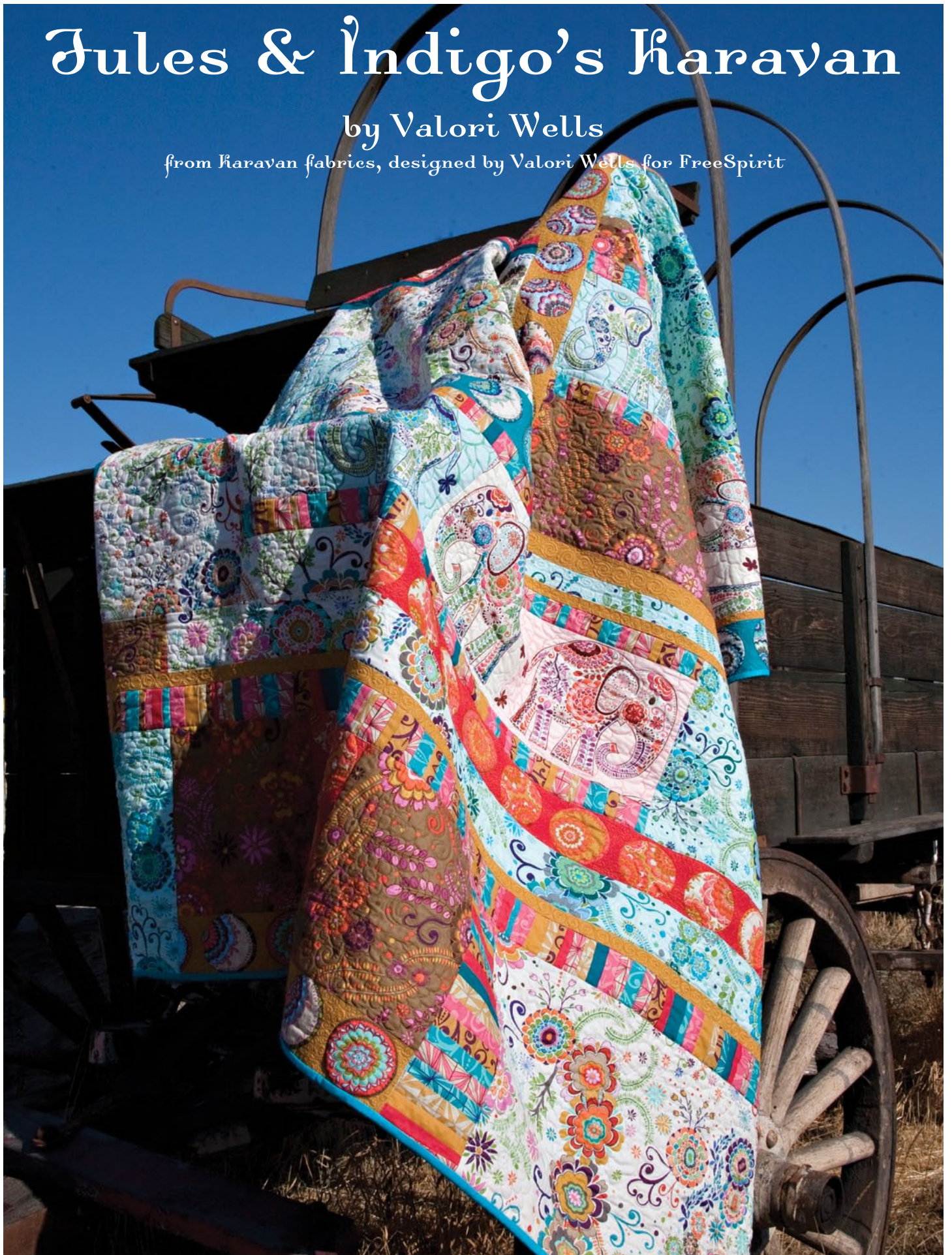

Finished quilt size 80 1/2" x 80 1/2"

BEFORE CUTTING AND SEWING, PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS TO FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THEM.
A 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout.

Materials Needed and Cutting Instructions

(all measurements based on accurate cutting, 1/4" seam allowance, and 42" wide strips)

3/4 yard PWVW-038 Marrakech Peacock	A4, A22, and B7 – cut a total of 3 - 9" x 11 1/2" rectangles A12 – cut 1 - 15" x 14" rectangle
3/4 yard PWVW-038 Marrakech Blossom	A5 and B9 – cut a total of 2 - 9" x 11 1/2" rectangles A24 – cut 1 - 9" x 12 1/2" rectangle B25 – cut 1 - 11 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle
3/4 yard PWVW-038 Marrakech Artisan	A6, A23, and B8 – cut a total of 3 - 9" x 11 1/2" rectangles A20 – cut 1 - 15 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangle
1 1/3 yard PWVW-039 Kashmir Artisan	Cutting suggestion – cut a 4", 4 1/2", 5", and 2 - 15" by the width of the fabric strips. Then cut the * pieces first. Cut the remaining pieces from the left-over pieces of the strips. *A1 – cut 1 - 4 1/2" x 39 1/2" strip A3 – cut 1 - 6 1/2" x 9" rectangle *A11 – cut 1 - 5" x 36" strip B14 – cut 1 - 14" x 16" rectangle *A13 – cut 1 - 15" x 22 1/2" strip *B17 – cut 1 - 4" x 31" strip B6 – cut 1 - 6 1/2" x 9" rectangle *B30 – cut 1 - 15" x 31" strip B12 – cut 1 - 4 x 14 1/2" rectangle
1 1/8 yard PWVW-039 Kashmir Peacock	Cutting suggestion – cut a 2", 3", 4", 11 1/2", and 12 1/2" by the width of the fabric strips. Then cut the * pieces first. Cut the remaining piece from a left-over piece of a strip. *A16 – cut 1 - 3" x 38 1/2" strip B31 – cut 1 - 7 1/2" x 15" rectangle *A18 – cut 1 - 11 1/2" x 23 1/2" strip *B3 – cut 1 - 2" x 30 1/2" strip *B11 – cut 1 - 12 1/2" x 16" rectangle *B18 – cut 1 - 4" x 32" strip *B20 – cut 1 - 4" x 23" strip
2/3 yard PWVW-039 Kashmir Fig	A19 – cut 1 - 4 1/2" x 23 1/2" strip B16 – cut 1 - 4" x 7 1/2" rectangle A27 – cut 1 - 8" x 35" strip B23 and B27 – cut a total of 2 - 10" x 11 1/2" rectangles
5/8 yard PWVW-042 Bangle Ruby	B13 – cut 1 - 4" x 41" strip B19 – cut 1 - 4" x 23" strip B24 and B26 – cut a total of 2 - 4" x 11 1/2" strips B33 – cut 1 - 4" x 20 1/2" strip
3/8 yard PWVW-042 Bangle Peacock	A17 – cut 1 - 4" x 38 1/2" strip A28 – cut 1 - 4" x 35" strip B1 – cut 1 - 4" x 39 1/2" strip
2/3 yard PWVW-042 Bangle Curry	A8 – cut 1 - 4" x 39 1/2" strip A14 – cut 1 - 4" x 20 1/2" strip A15 – cut 1 - 4" x 41" strip B28 – cut 1 - 4" x 34 1/2" strip B32 – cut 1 - 4" x 20 1/2" strip
1/4 yard each of the following 6 fabrics: PWVW-040 Quartz Blossom PWVW-040 Quartz Curry PWVW-040 Quartz Peacock PWVW-041 Savannah Blossom PWVW-041 Savannah Curry PWVW-041 Savannah Peacock	From each of these fabrics cut 2 - 1" x 42" strips, cut 2 - 1 1/4" x 42" strips, and cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips.

1/4 yard Free Spirit Designer Solid S47 - Spark Gold	A26 – cut 1 - 1" x 27 1/2" strip B2 – cut 1 - 2" x 30 1/2" strip B4 – cut 1 - 1" x 30 1/2" strip B21 – cut 2 - 1" x 42" strips. Then sew together lengthwise into one long strip. From this strip cut 1 - 1" x 76 1/2" strip. B34 – cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strip
1/8 yard Free Spirit Designer Solid S02 - Red	A9 – cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 39 1/2" rectangle
1/8 yard Free Spirit Designer Solid S81 - Oriental Blue	A10 – cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 36" rectangle B15 – cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 16" rectangle
5/8 yard binding	• 5 yards quilt backing • 86" x 86" quilt batting

Sewing Instructions

1. Starting with the 6 fabrics you have cut 2 - 1" x 42" strips, cut 2 - 1 1/4" x 42" strips, and cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips from each, sew them together, right sides together, in random order, using a 1/4" seam. **Figure 1.**

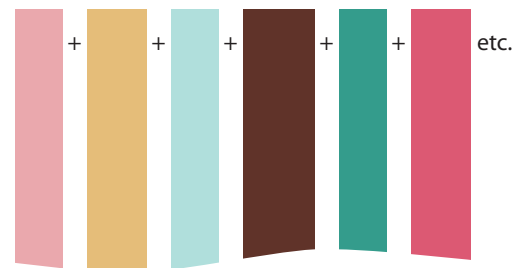

Sewing suggestion: alternate adding strips starting to sew at the top of the strip, next strip start to sew at the bottom of the strip. This will help keep your strip set "growing" too long at one end. Press often.

Once these are sewn, you may want to cut the strip set in half and sew the bottom half to the top half so you have longer segments to work with. Cut the following strips for your units needed. If the strip set is not long enough, cut 2 strips and sew them together to get the length you need.

From the strip set cut the following:

B29 - cut 1 - 5" x 15" strip
A7 - cut 1 - 2" x 39 1/2" strip
A25 - cut 1 - 2" x 34 1/2" strip
B5 - cut 1 - 2" x 39 1/2" strip
A2 - cut 1 - 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" strip
A21 - cut 1 - 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" strip
B10 - cut 1 - 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" strip
B22 - cut 1 - 3" x 76 1/2" strip

2. The quilt top is divided into two sections, A and B.

Referring to the quilt diagram, start with section A, sewing A1 to A2. Press after each piece is joined to another piece.

Sew A3 to A4 to A5 to A6. Sew this unit to the A1/A2 unit.

Sew A7 to A8 to A9. Sew this unit to the A1/A7 unit. Press.

Sew A10 to A11. Sew A12 to A13. Sew the A10/A11 unit to A12/A13 unit.

Sew A14 to the left-hand side of the A10/A13 unit. Sew this unit to the A1/A9 unit.

Sew A15 to the right-hand side of this unit. Press.

3. To complete the A section, sew A16 to A17. Sew A18 to A19. Then sew A20 to the right-hand side of this unit.

Sew A21 to the bottom of the A19/A20 unit. Sew A22 to A23 to A24.

Then sew A25 to the bottom of this unit. Sew the A22/A25 unit to the A18/A21 unit.

Sew A26 to the right-hand side of the A18/A25 unit. Sew A27 to the bottom of this unit.

Sew A28 to the right-hand side of the A18/A27 unit. Sew A16/A17 to the top of this unit.

Join the two A units sewing A16/28 to the right-hand side of the A1/A16 unit. Press.

4. Referring to the quilt diagram and starting with B2, sew this to B3 and then to B4.

Sew B6 to B7 to B8 to B9. Sew B5 to the top of this unit and B10 to the bottom of it.

Sew B11 to the right-hand side of the unit.

Sew B12 to B13, then sew this to the bottom of the B5/B11 unit.

Sew B14 to B15 and sew this to the left-hand side of the unit.

Sew B1 to the B2/B4 unit. Sew this to the top of the B5/B15 unit.

Sew B16 to B17 to B18. Sew B21 to the bottom of this.

Sew this unit to the bottom of the B1/B15 unit. Sew B19 to B20 and sew this to the left-hand side of the unit. Set aside.

Sew B23 to B24 to B25 to B26 to B27. Sew B28 to the bottom of this. Sew B31 to the left-hand side of this unit.

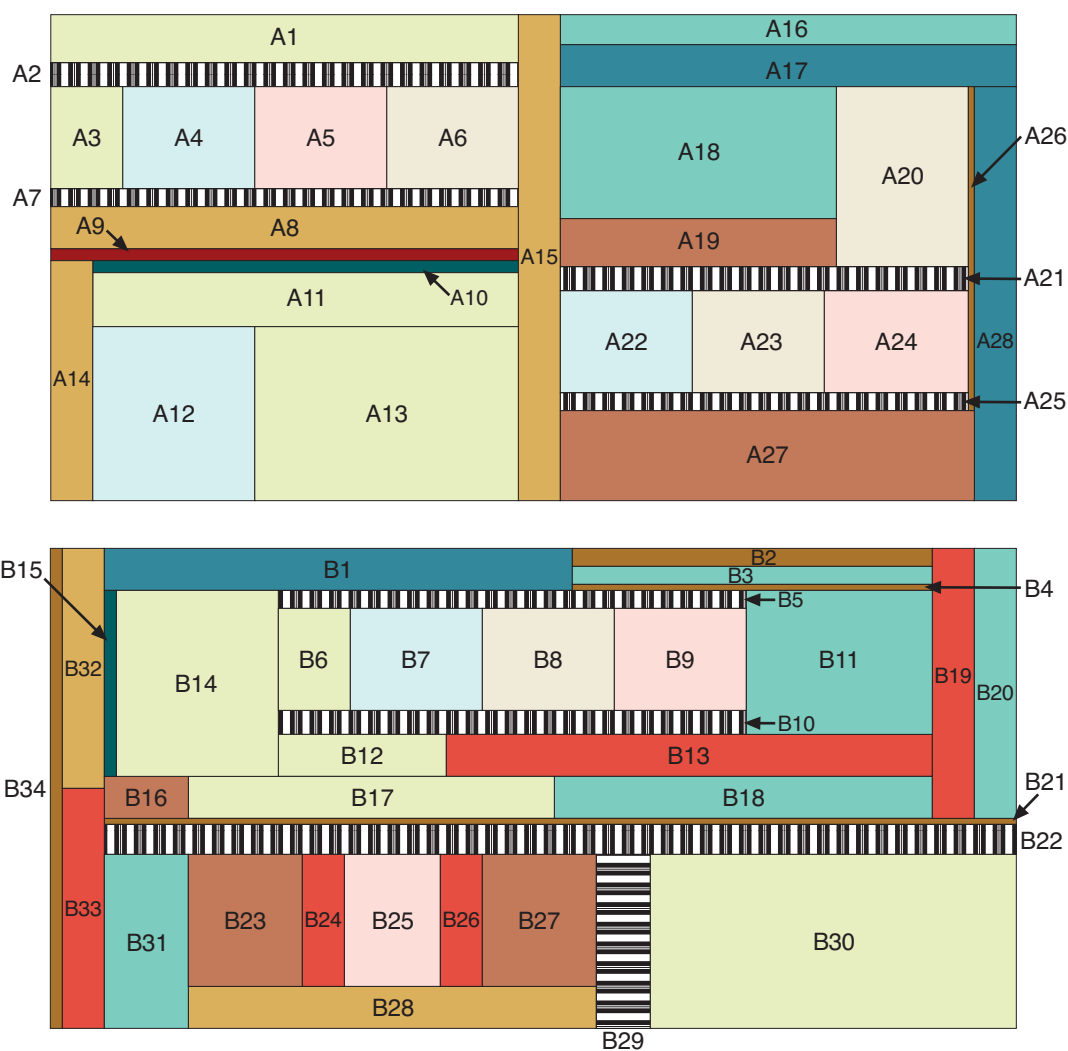
Sew B29 to B30 and sew this to the right-hand side of the B23/B28 unit.

Sew B22 to the top of this. Sew this unit to the B1/B21 unit.

Sew B32 to B33. Sew B34 to the left-hand side of this. Sew this unit to the left-hand side of the B1/B31 unit.

Sew the completed A section to the completed B section. Press.

5. Layer, quilt, and finish. We quilted floral and graphic motifs inspired by the fabrics over the top of this quilt.
